The Application Process:

Rotary selects its members very carefully through a prescribed procedure. New members must be proposed by current members of the club.

Here are the qualifications, expectations, and the procedure:

Qualifications for Membership:

According to the bylaws of Rotary International:

A club shall be composed of active members who are adult persons of good character and good business and professional reputation,

(i) engaged as a proprietor, partner, corporate officer, or manager of any worthy and recognized business or profession; or

(ii) hold an important position in any worthy and recognized business or profession or any branch or agency thereof and have executive capacity with discretionary authority; or

(iii) having retired from any position listed in sub-section (i) or (ii) of this subsection

Expectations of Members:

- 1. Members are expected to maintain 60% attendance (between Tuesday meetings and volunteer service)
- 2. Active participation on at least one of our many committees, which is the best way to get to know other members, and strengthen our connection to one another.
- 3. Generally participate in and support the activities of the club whenever possible with both time and treasure.

Members' Financial Obligations:

- 1. Admission Fee (one-time payable with your application): \$250.00
- 2. Annual Dues (due each June for the period Jul 1-Jun 30): Currently \$397.00 (subject to change each May 1; dues are pro-rated at time of application for months remaining until Jun 30)
- **3.** Member Lunch Costs at our weekly meetings are currently: Full Buffet: \$11, Soup/Salad Only: \$7, or Beverage Only: Free.
- 4. Although not "required" we provide many opportunities for you to make "suggested" contributions to our local Lincoln Rotary Club #14 Foundation, and The Rotary (International) Foundation, to support our charitable causes.
